ELIGIBILITY BASICS

Students aged 18-49 enrolled at least half-time must meet income and citizenship guidelines and at least one exemption:

- Work 20+ hours/week, <u>or</u> have workstudy, <u>or</u> enrolled in an LPIE, <u>or</u> work on campus.
- Receive Cal Grant A or B, <u>or</u> be a parent of a dependent.

 Responsible for a dependent child or household member

57% of students recently surveyed were eligible!
